


Start the installation under the passenger side of the vehicle. Locate the front (3) factory studs along the inner side of the body panel, (Figure 1).


IMPORTANT: Use a wire brush or thread chaser die to remove excess paint or undercoating from threaded studs as necessary.




Select (1) Mounting Bracket.

NOTE: All (6) Brackets are universal and will fit left or right side. Attach the Mounting Bracket to the (3) factory studs with (3) 8mm Flat Washers and (3) 8mm Nylon Lock Nuts, (Figures 2-3). Leave brackets loose at this time.











STEP 3


Repeat Steps 1-2 to install the Mounting Brackets in the center and rear mounting locations along the body panel, (Figures 4-6).

STEP 4

Once all Brackets have been fully installed, select (1) Running Board.











STEP 5

Place the Running Board on top of the Brackets. Locate the channel in the bottom of the Running Board. Select (3) 8mm Double Bolt Plates. Insert the Bolt Plates into the channel in the bottom of the Running Board closest to the Brackets, (Figure 7). Lift the Running Board up and guide the studs down through the Brackets.



Attach the Running Board to the Brackets with (6) 8mm Flat Washers and (6) 8mm Nylon Lock Nuts, (Figures 8-9). Do not tighten hardware at this time.







STEP 7

Properly level and adjust the Running Board and fully tighten all hardware.



Repeat Steps 1-7 for Driver/left Running Board installation.



Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.
