





### STEPI

REMOVE CONTENTS FROM BOX. VERIFY ALL PARTS ARE PRESENT. READ INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY. USE ILLUSTRATION TO IDENTIFY BRACKETS AND RUNNING BOARDS.

### STEP 2

Starting on the Passenger/Right side, front of the vehicle, remove the plastic plugs or hex bolts covering the (2) threaded holes in the body panel, (Figure 1). Select (1) Front Mounting Bracket, (Figure 2). Attach the Bracket to the vehicle using the included (2) 8mm Hex Bolts, (2) 8mm Lock Washers and (2) 8mm Flat Washers, (Figures 2 & 3). Do not tighten hardware.






(2) 8mm Hex Bolts





| (Fig 4) Passenger/Right side | 2nd mounting location

Next, move to the next (2nd) center mounting location, (Figure 4).

### STEP 4


Select (1) Center Mounting Bracket, (Figure 5). Repeat **STEP 2** to install the Center Mounting Bracket, (Figure 6).


**IMPORTANT:** The 2nd, 3rd and Rear Brackets look similar but the 2nd one is unique. Use the illustration above and Figure 5 to help identify each Bracket.








Continue to the 3rd and Rear mounting locations at the back of the cab, (Figure 7). Repeat **STEP 2** to install (2) Rear Mounting Brackets, (Figures 6—11).















Once all (4) Mounting Brackets have been fully installed, carefully unwrap (1) Running Board. Place the Running Board on top of the (4) Mounting Brackets. Locate the channel in the bottom of the Running Board. Select (4) 8mm Double Bolt Plates. Insert the Bolt Plates into the channel in the bottom of the Running Board closest to the Brackets, (Figure 12). Lift the Running Board up and guide the studs down through the Brackets.







Attach the Running Board to the Mounting Brackets with the included (8) 8mm Flat Washers and (8) 8mm Nylon Lock Nuts, (Figures 13—17). Do not tighten at this time.

Level and adjust the Running Board as desired and tighten all hardware.

### STEP 9

Repeat **STEPS 2—8** for Driver/Right side Running Board installation.

### STEP 10

Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.
