

PROCEDURE:

READ INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY BEFORE STARTING INSTALLATION. ASSISTANCE IS RECOMMENDED TO AVOID POSSIBLE INJURY OR DAMAGE TO THE VEHICLE.

Remove the license plate and bracket. On models with factory fog lights and/or bumper sensors, unplug the wiring harness leading to the bumper. Move harness away from bumper.

Open the hood and remove the plastic cover between the top of the radiator and the grille, (Figure 1). Next, carefully remove the grille from the vehicle.







(Fig 3) Grille removed to access top bumper bolts

NOTE: Grille is held in place with screws at the top and several clips, (Figure 1). Remove the screws and firmly pull the grille straight out from the vehicle to release the grille from the clips, (Figures 2 & 3).


WARNING! Do not crawl under bumper unless the bumper is properly supported on blocks or stands or the bumper may fall.

STEP 3

Remove the outer bumper supports leading from the outside of the frame to the ends of the bumper, (Figure 4).

STEP 5

Once bumper has been removed, reinstall the plastic grille and cover removed in **STEP 2**.

STEP 4

Place blocks or jack stands under the front bumper to support it during mounting bolt removal. Once the bumper has been safely supported, remove the bumper bolts attaching the bumper assembly to the frame bracket bolted to the end of the frame, (Figure 5).

WARNING! Assistance is required to hold the bumper in place during bolt removal to prevent the bumper from falling. Carefully slide the bumper assembly off of the ends of the frame.


Do not crawl under bumper unless the bumper is properly supported on blocks or stands or the bumper may fall.

STEP 6


Remove both bumper brackets from the end of the frame, (Figures 6—8).

NOTE: Do not remove the tow hooks if equipped, (Figure 7).


WARNING! Do not crawl under bumper unless the bumper is properly supported on blocks or stands or the bumper may fall.

(Fig 7) Bumper brackets removed. Remove seal around tow hooks if equipped




(Fig 8) Example driver/left bumper bracket removed on model without tow hooks

STEP 7

Carefully unwrap the Bumper assembly. Select the Bumper Hoop. Remove the rubber plugs from the top of the bumper. Attach the Hoop to the top of the bumper with (4) 8mm x 25mm Button Head Bolts, (8) 8mm Flat Washers, (4) 8mm Lock Washers and (4) 8mm Hex Nuts, (Figure 9).

NOTE: Hoop Installation is optional.

(Fig 9) Remove rubber plugs to attach Hoop to top of Bumper


STEP 8


Determine if outer accessory lights, (not included), will be installed at this time.

Outer LED cube style light installation (light not included).

- **a.** Remove the hardware attaching the outer mesh fill panels to the Bumper, (Figure 10).
- **b.** Attach lights to the mounting tabs at the outer-ends of the Bumper, (Figure 10).
- **c.** Follow the light manufacturer's instruction to properly wire lights once Bumper is installed.

STEP 9

With assistance, position the Bumper Assembly up to the ends of the frame. Temporarily support the weight of the Bumper.

WARNING: To avoid possible injury or damage to the vehicle, do not proceed until the Bumper is fully and safely supported.

STEP II

Level and adjust the bumper and fully tighten all hardware.

STEP 10

Line up the (2) upper slots in the driver/left side mounting plate on the back of the Bumper with the mounting holes in the end of the frame. Reuse the factory bolts to attach the Bumper to the plate, (Figure 11).

NOTE: Repeat this Step to attach the passenger/right side of the Bumper to the frame.

WARNING! Do not crawl under bumper unless the bumper is properly supported on blocks or stands or the bumper may fall.


STEP 12


Top Hoop mounted bar style LED light installation (light not included).

Select (1) "L" Light Bracket. Attach the Bracket to the bottom of the Hoop with (1) 8mm x 25mm Button Head Bolt, (2) 8mm Flat Washers, (1) 8mm Lock Washer and (1) 8mm Hex Nut, (Figure 12).

NOTE: Do not tighten hardware at this time. Repeat to attach the remaining "L" Bracket.

STEP 13

Select the light bar, (not included). Attach light bar to "L" Brackets with (2) 8mm x 16mm Hex Bolts, (2) 8mm Lock Washers and (2) 8mm Flat Washers, (Figure 12). Adjust the width of the Brackets to the light and fully tighten bracket hardware.

STEP 14

If front license plate is required, attach the License Plate Bracket to the holes in the bumper with the included (2) 6mm x 20mm Button Head Screws, (4) 6mm Flat Washers and (2) 6mm Nylon Lock Nuts. Insert (2) Plastic Plugs into the square holes in the Bracket. Reuse the factory screws to attach the license plate to the plastic plugs, (Figure 13).

STEP 15

Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.
