






WARNING:

Allow time for the muffler to completely cool before removing rear bumper.





Remove the factory bumper by removing the side brackets, (Fig 1), and the two inner brackets behind the factory bumper, (Fig 2).






Insert (1) 12mm Double Nut Plate into the driver side frame channel and line up the threaded welded nuts with the (2) slots in the outside of the frame, (Figs 3-4).










STEP 3

Repeat Step 2 to install (1) 12mm Double Nut Plate on the passenger side frame channel.



NOTE: Cover the factory hitch, (if equipped), with a piece of cardboard or masking tape to protect the finish on the Rear Bumper.



STEP 5

If installing outer LED Lights, (not included):


a. Attach the LED Light to the mounting tab on the back of the Bumper. If necessary, remove the screen from the back of the Bumper to allow for adjustment, (Fig 5).

b. Follow the light manufacturer's instructions to properly wire the lights.



STEP 6

With assistance, carefully position the Rear Bumper up to the outside of the frame. Attach the Bumper to the Nut Plates with the included (4) 12mm Hex Bolts, (4) 12mm Lock Washers and (4) 12mm Flat Washers, (Figs 6-8). Attach the Bumper to the threaded inserts in the sides of the frame using (4) 10mm Hex Bolts, (4) 10mm Lock Washers and (4) 10mm Flat Washers, (Figs 6-8). Do not tighten hardware at this time.





STEP 7

Level and adjust the Rear Bumper and tighten all hardware at this time.

NOTE: If vehicle is equipped with factory tow hitch, leave a 1/4" gap between the Rear Bumper and the hitch.



Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.
