

### STEP I

Begin at the rear of the vehicle. Remove the license plate from the bumper. Unplug the wiring harness leading to the rear bumper (Fig 1). Move all wiring harnesses away from the bumper.



(Fig 1) Unplug and remove 7-wire trailer plug, unplug license plate lights and sensors if equipped

### STEP 2

#### Determine if vehicle is equipped with a factory receiver hitch

#### • Models with Factory Receiver Hitch

 ${\bf a.}$  Use a flat blade screwdriver to pry the plastic cover from the top of the rear bumper on the passenger and driver side edge (Fig 2).


**b.** Remove the plastic screw under the license plate (Fig 3). Release the clips and factory hardware under the passenger and driver side of the bumper and proceed to remove the center plastic cover on the top of the bumper (Figs 4-5).

**c.** Place blocks or jack stands under the bumper to support it during mounting bolt removal. Once the bumper has been safely supported, remove the factory hardware attaching the bumper to the top and bottom of the receiver hitch and remove the bumper. **NOTE:** Leave hitch attached.


**WARNING!** Do not remove bumper bolts unless the bumper is properly supported on blocks or stands or the bumper may fall.



(Fig 2) Use a flat blade screwdriver to pry the plastic cover from the top of edges of the bumper



(Fig 3) Remove plastic screw under the license plate.








**d.** Select the Passenger/Right Mounting Bracket. Attach the bracket to the receiver hitch with (1) factory bolt, (1) Large Spacer, (1) Small Spacer, (3) 14mm Hex Bolts, (5) 14mm Flat Washers, (3) 14mm Lock Washers and (2) 14mm Hex Nuts, (Fig 9). Do not tighten hardware at this time. Repeat this Step to attach the Driver/Left Mounting Bracket to the frame.


#### • Models without Factory Receiver Hitch


**a.** Place blocks or jack stands under the bumper to support it during factory bolt removal. Once the bumper has been safely supported, remove the factory hardware attaching the bumper brackets to the sides of the frame, (Fig 6). Remove Bumper with brackets from the frame.



**b.** Skip to next if there are factory support brackets. Select the Passenger/Right Support Bracket. Attach the bracket to the bottom of the frame with (2) factory bolts, (Figs 7-8).

**Note:** The support brackets that come with the kit install in the same place factory support brackets would be installed.






(Fig 8) Passenger/Right Frame Mounting Location with the Support Bracket attached (Models without hitch)

**c.** Next, select the Passenger/Right Mounting Bracket. Attach the bracket to the outside of the frame with (1) factory bolt, (1) Large Spacer, (1) Small Spacer, (3) 14mm Hex Bolts, (5) 14mm Flat Washers, (3) 14mm Lock Washers and (2) 14mm Hex Nuts, (Fig 9). Do not tighten hardware at this time.





**d.** Repeat Steps 2a-2c to attach the Driver/Right Support and Mounting Bracket to the frame.


### STEP 3

Release the wiring harness from the clips attached to the back of the bumper. Remove license plate lights and sensors. Mark each sensor and light with the correct location.



Locate the (4) sensor mounting sleeves on the backside of the bumper.


- Models with sensors
- a. Select (1) factory sensor.
- $\boldsymbol{b}.$  Remove the plastic ring around the sensor, (Fig 10).
- $\ensuremath{\textbf{c}}.$  Insert the sensors into the sleeve on the back of the Bumper.
- d. Secure Sensor with (2) 4mm Button Head Bolts.
- e. Repeat previous Steps for the remaining Sensor Plugs.



#### • Models without sensors

**a.** Insert (4) Sensor Plugs into the sensor sleeves on the back of the Bumper.

b. Secure with (8) 4mm Button Head Bolts, (Fig 11).



(Fig 11) Push Sensor or Sensor Plug into mounting sleeve. Use 4mm Bolts to lock in place. (Sensor Plug installation shown)




### Determine if Lights will be installed (light not included).

a. Remove the mesh panel from the Light Location.


**b.** Attach Light to the mounting plate on the inside of the Bumper, (Fig 12).





### STEP 6

Select (1) 12mm Bolt Plate. Insert the Bolt Plate into the Passenger/Right side of the Bumper. Thread (2) 12mm Plastic Retainers onto the threads to hold the Bolt Plate in place, (Fig 13). Repeat this Step for the Driver/Left side of the Bumper.






With assistance, position the Bumper up to the Mounting Brackets. Temporarily support the weight of the Bumper. **WARNING:** To avoid possible injury or damage to the vehicle, do not proceed until the bumper is fully and safely supported.

# STEP 8

Attach the Bumper to the Mounting Brackets with (4) 12mm Flat Washers, (4) 12mm Lock Washers and (4) 12mm Hex Nuts, (Figs 14-15). Do not fully tighten hardware.

**WARNING!** Do not crawl under bumper unless the bumper is properly supported on blocks or stands or the bumper may fall.






## STEP 9

Level and adjust the Bumper and fully tighten all hardware

# STEP 10

Reinstall the trailer plug, (Fig 16). **NOTE:** Use a flat blade screwdriver to carefully pry the metal clip on the plug out to grab the edge of the opening.



### STEP II

Insert (2) License Plate Plugs into the holes in the bumper. Insert the License Plate Lights into the square holes in the license plate area of bumper, (Fig 16).



Reattach the wiring harnesses.

STEP 13

Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.
