




Use illustration to identify brackets and running boards.



Starting on the passenger side, front of the vehicle, remove the plastic plugs or hex bolts covering the (2) threaded holes in the body panel, (Fig 1). Select the passenger side Front Mounting Bracket, (Fig 2). Attach the Bracket to the vehicle using the included (2) 8mm Hex Bolts, (2) 8mm Lock Washers and (2) 8mm Flat Washers, (Figs 2-3). Do not tighten hardware at this time.











Select (1) Plastic Bracket Cover and (2) Retaining Clips. Slide the Cover over the passenger/right front Bracket. Line up the (2) mounting holes in the Cover with the holes in the Bracket. Insert the Clip into the holes and push center pin to expand Clip, (Figs 4-5). Repeat this Step for all Cover installations. Notes install the plastic covers onto the brackets before installing the side bar.




Next, move to the center mounting location, (Fig 6).

**NOTE:** Installation will use the 1st, 2nd & 4th mounting locations for the Mounting Brackets.












Select the passenger side Center Mounting Bracket, (Fig 7).

**IMPORTANT:** The Center and Rear Brackets look similar but each one is unique. Use the illustration above and Fig 7 to help identify each Bracket. Repeat Steps 1-2 to install the Passenger side Center Bracket, (Figs 8-9).



NOTE: The Center Bracket has the mounting tabs facing opposite direction while the Rear Bracket has the mounting tabs facing the same direction. When installed correctly, all lower tabs will face towards the rear.










Continue to the last mounting location at the back of the cab, (Fig 10). Repeat Steps 1-2 to install the Passenger side Rear Bracket, (Figs 11-12).

### STEP 6

Once all (3) Mounting Brackets have been fully installed, carefully unwrap the Passenger/right Sidebar. Use the illustration above to help determine the correct Sidebar. Place the Sidebar on top of the (3) Mounting Brackets.













Attach the Sidebar to the Mounting Brackets with the included (6) 8mm Combo Bolts, (Figs 13-16). Do not tighten at this time.











Level and adjust the Sidebar as desired and tighten all hardware.

# STEP 9

Repeat Steps 2-8 for Driver/left Sidebar installation.

#### STEP IO

Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.
