Driver Left Side


STEP I

REMOVE CONTENTS FROM BOX. VERIFY ALL PARTS ARE PRESENT. READ INSTRUCTIONS CAREFULLY. CLEAN MOUNTING STUDS WITH WIRE BRUSH TO REMOVE PAINT AND DEBRIS.


STEP 2

Starting on the Passenger/Right side front of the vehicle (Fig1).

Passenger Side Installation Pictured




Attach (1) Passenger/Right Mounting Bracket to the Front Location with (2) 8mm Flat Washers and (2) 8mm Flange Nuts. (Fig 2A)



ATTENTION:

Some Frontier models have front factory studs that are too short to fit both Flat Washers and Flange Nuts. In this case, <u>omit the</u> **Flat Washers and only install the Flange Nuts.** (Fig 2B)









Repeat **STEP 2** to attach the remaining Passenger/Right Mounting Brackets to the center and rear locations (Figs 3 & 4).

(Fig 6) Sidebar attached to the Front Mounting Bracket

STEP 5

Level and adjust the Sidebar and tighten all hardware.

STEP 4

Select the Passenger/Right Sidebar. Carefully place Sidebar on the brackets.

IMPORTANT: DO NOT slide or rotate Sidebar on cradles, or damage to the finish may result. Attach Sidebar to the Mounting Brackets with (6) 8mm Combo Bolts (Figs 5 & 6). DO NOT tighten hardware at this time.

Repeat STEPS 1-5 to attach the Driver/Left Sidebar.



Do periodic inspections to the installation to make sure that all hardware is secure and tight.
